Legislation was reviewed during the Legislative Session by members of the Chamber's Policy Committee, chaired by Bruce Newcomb of Boise State University. Vice Chairman of the committee was Mike Reynoldson of Micron Technology, Inc. The Chamber is pleased the Legislature approved a tax credit for new jobs, a

GARVEE Bond and preserved urban renewal. The Chamber was disappointed the Senate was not able to vote on a sales tax exemption for out-of-state aircraft parts which would have created 100 new jobs in Boise.
